



### TRANSIT application checklist for 2016 CHIPRC AiR

Thank you for your interest in the upcoming TRANSIT residency program. Here is a list to help you remember to include all parts of the application packet. Best of luck!

To apply, please submit the following:

- Your CV/resume.
- The TRANSIT 2016 Applicant Contact Info form, filled out by you (download from website).
- A brief statement of what you hope to achieve during your residency and why the Chicago Publishers Resource Center (CHIPRC) is your preferred location.
- A brief artistic statement, about your work in general.
- A minimum of five (no more than ten) DIGITAL samples of your most recent work, in Mac-compatible electronic format [images may be low-resolution (72dpi) or hi-res (300 dpi), but file size not to exceed 6 inches x 6 inches]: images of previously self-published bound zines or comics, link(s) to your comics and art online, links to work previously published, or images of comics or art which demonstrate your technical ability and creative aptitude. Website links are acceptable but must correspond with specific images and **MUST INCLUDE A NUMBERED LIST** with corresponding information of the specific samples we are to consider from the site(s). CD-ROMs or DVDs are acceptable as an alternative means of sending your digital content.
- Accompanying numbered list (Word doc recommended) with the details of the specific five to ten samples we are to consider. All supporting documentation must be correctly labeled: include the title, date of work, medium and dimensions of each work.
- A \$15 (US Dollars) non-refundable application fee.  
You may pay this fee by credit card by using our Paypal account, or checks can be made out to *Transit Residency NFP* and mailed to us (MUST be received by Feb 29<sup>th</sup> to be considered for residency) - please make sure to write "2016 CHIPRC application fee" in the payment notes.

Complete applications (and all fees) must be received by 5pm CST on Monday, February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2016 to be considered. Hardcopy packets and/or checks postmarked with this date will be accepted.

\*\*\* We encourage you to send us your application electronically (via email to [meredith@transitresidency.org](mailto:meredith@transitresidency.org)). However, CD-ROMs or DVDs are acceptable alternative means of sending your digital content. If sending your application materials via email or on a disc, remember to use *YOUR NAME as part of your file-names!*

Hardcopy samples will not be reviewed or returned (and still require a list with titles, dates, mediums, and dimensions of work).

We encourage you to send your CV, artist statements, and list of work sample details electronically, even if you are sending hardcopies and/or your application fee as a check.
